

Administrative information: bad and good examples of tables

Here is a bad example of a table, generated by pasting a table directly from Word:

Here is an equivalent table, optimised to work well in Drupal, using the rules described [here](#). In this case, the table has no width parameters, because it is naturally rather skinny. The pdf version spreads the table across the page, but still looks OK.
