

Language Extension Activity

Overview:

A Language Extension Activity is available in any of the 5 foreign languages and the British Sign Language course, offered by the Centre for Languages and Inter-Communication (CLIC).

CLIC caters for a range of levels in French, German, Japanese, Chinese and Spanish.

Language courses run over 15 weeks in Michaelmas and Lent Terms.

Eligibility:

You must be registered on a language course at the start of Michaelmas term, you cannot choose a language course for your ExA mid-way through the year.

CLIC will ask third year language students to confirm if they wish to use their course for ExA credit during Michaelmas term.`

Please note that in order to qualify for the 20 marks of standard credit, you must attend a minimum of 80% of the course. You will **not** need to submit a portfolio or homework unless you wish to compete the course for a digital badge or certificate.
